Community Steering Committee (CSC) Background

- February 2022: CARB voted in support of nominating East Oakland
- Partnership Agreement between CBE and BAAQMD
- CBE & BAAQMD conducted outreach in East Oakland
- CBE and BAAQMD reviewed CSC applications
 - Criteria: majority East Oakland residents and a broad representation of "community sectors"
- Importance of community leadership and vision
- Kicked off in September 2022



Timelines

- AB 617
 - CERP to be adopted by air district board one year after selection by CARB.
- AB 1749
 - CERP development can extend to 2 years with community steering committee, air district, and CARB agreement.





What is a vision?

- Blue sky thinking how do you picture the future?
- A collaborative process in which a community creates the future it wants by identifying their purpose, values, and shared aspirations for the future.

"Our vision is an atmosphere that enables people and the planet to thrive – a stabilized climate with warming limited to 1.5C and drastically reduced air pollution."
