APPROVED by the CSC: Roles & Responsibilities of Steering Committee Co-Chairs

- Provide CSC leadership and guidance along with CBE staff
 - 1-2 orientation meetings with Air District & CBE staff & Just Cities
- Help plan CSC agendas, facilitate breakout sessions and discussions
 - Meet multiple times per month with Air District & CBE staff to prepare for CSC meetings (including agendas) (about 5 hours of meetings per month *in addition* to monthly CSC meetings)
- Provide direction for Air District & CBE to develop Community Emissions Reduction Plan
- If you miss 2 consecutive Co-Chair meetings, another Co-Chair will be selected.

Additional stipend of \$75 per/hr for each Co-chair to compensate for participation in meetings



CBE and Air District: Hours of Availability for Agenda Planning Meetings

Once the Co-Chairs are selected, we will do our best to accommodate the availability of the Co-Chairs.

- Agenda planning meetings will be scheduled sometime between 8am - 6pm.
- We do not want this to be a barrier to the Co-Chairs.



APPROVED by the CSC: Criteria/Qualifications/Experience for Serving as Effective CSC Co-Chairs

- Top-to-bottom understanding of what the job is and the vision.
- Not easily persuaded.
- Not afraid of conflict. Experience resolving conflicts in healthy and productive ways (Nice to have conflict resolution/restorative justice experience);
- Solution-oriented (always working towards a solution).
- Have timelines in place to reach resolution.
- Experience working effectively with racially/culturally/linguistically/ generational diverse people;
- Active listener (a communication skill that involves going beyond simply hearing the words that another person speaks but also seeking to understand the meaning and intent behind them. It requires being an active participant in the communication process.);
- Experience managing large group dynamics;
- Demonstrated commitment and service to the East Oakland community
- Different Criteria/Experience for youth.

Co-Chair Voting Process

- 1. Hear 2-minute speeches from Candidates (15-30 minutes)
- 2. Questions to Candidates (30-40 minutes)
- 3. **Action**: Vote on Co-chairs (Roll Call) (15 minutes)
