- **Possible action:**
  - *Rules*



- **AB 617 Community Highlight:**
  - Greater Los Angeles Area Communities.
  - Indirect Source Rule
  - Implementing agency: South Coast AQMD (Air District)

# Focus Area: Transportation and Mobile Sources

- **Concern:**
  - Heavy-duty truck emissions
- **Possible actions:**
  - *Community-focused enforcement*



- **AB 617 Community Highlight:**
- Multiple Communities
  - Portable Emissions Acquisition System (PEAQs) Monitoring
- Implementing agency: CARB

# Focus Area: Public Health & Community Wellness

- **Concern:**
  - Diesel emissions exposure
- **Possible action:**
  - *Incentives*



- **AB 617 Community Highlight:**
- Stockton
- Create incentive program to fund zero-emission school buses
- Implementing agency: CARB/Air District

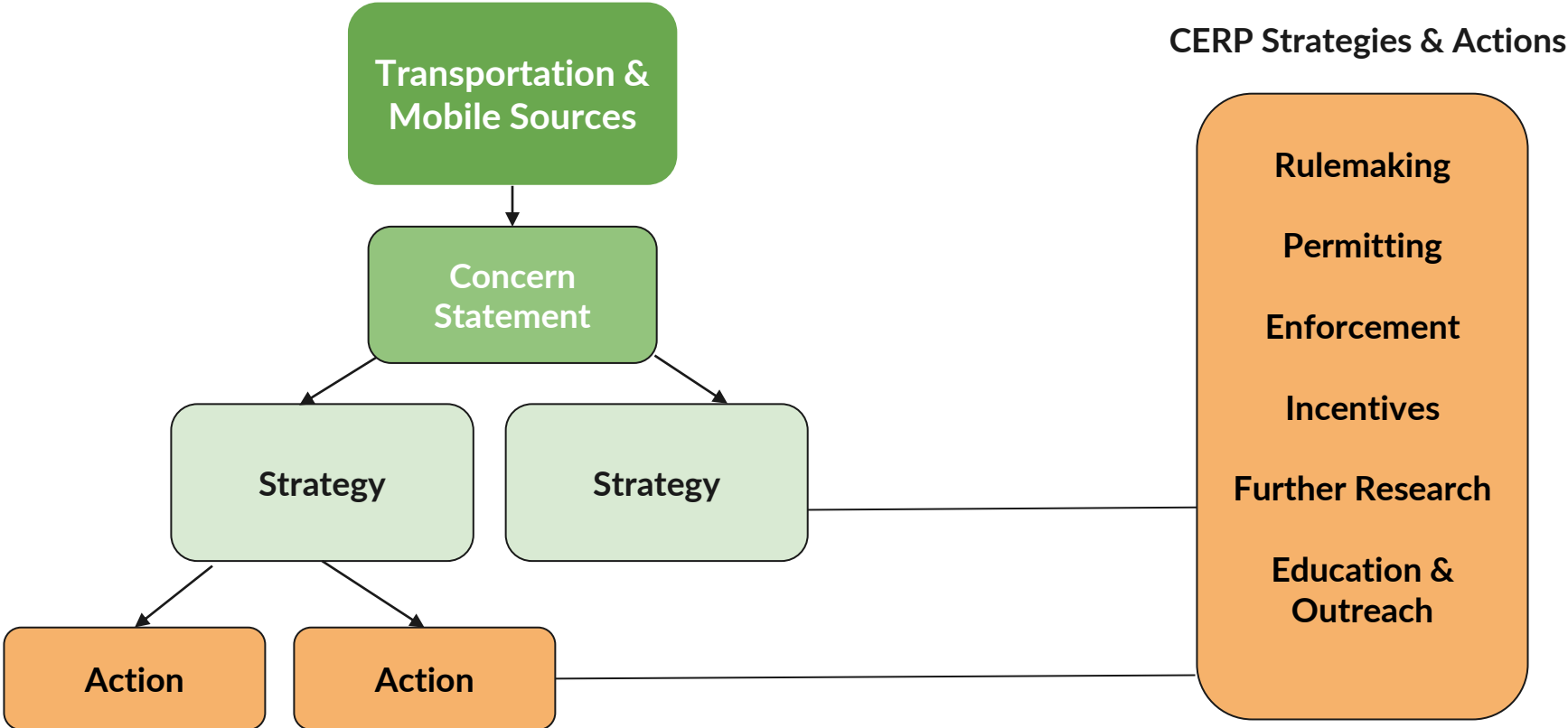

# Project Summary

- Environmental Democracy Project (EDP), in partnership with CERP Co-chairs, received a Community Air Grant from California Air Resources Board
- Project will look at air pollution impacts from illegal dumping and dumpsites in Oakland.
- Project will engage community members to identify community sites for air quality concerns, study the air pollution levels in the community, and collaborate with community members for actual clean-ups and pollution abatement in neglected neighborhoods.

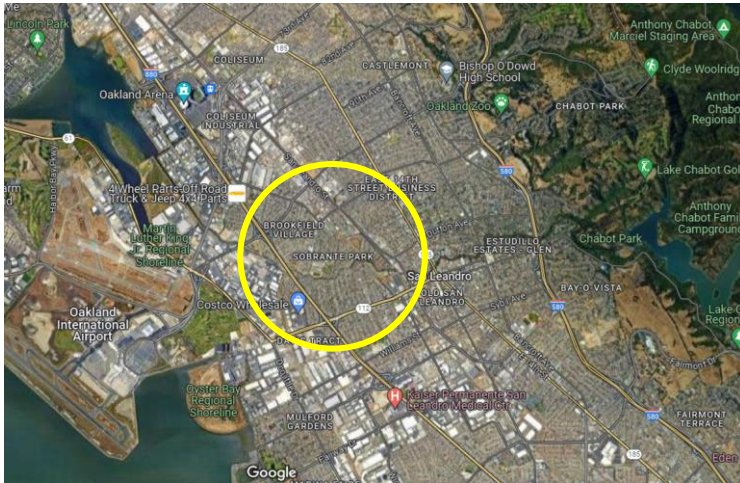
# Community Engagement

EDP and Mr. Charles Reed and Aiyahna Johnson will host a Project Orientation and form a Project Advisory Committee to lead the following for the grant:

- Community workshops
- Monthly Zoom rooms
- Tabling events
- Outreach at churches, schools, libraries, food programs, and shelters
- Partner meetings with other community groups and CBOs
- Youth Education and Engagement on air monitoring
