



Recap: Roles and Responsibilities



Steering Committee

Decision-making body
Membership as in current charter



Guides Steering Committee
Members include WOEIP, Air District, Youth Organization



Inter-Agency Working Group

Shares information with Steering Committee
Meets on an ad-hoc basis

Recap: Roles and Responsibilities



- Non-Steering Committee members can serve on subcommittees
- One community member and one agency member to co-chair each subcommittee
- Make recommendations to Steering Committee



Deeper dive: Strategy subcommittees



Structure

- Subcommittees will meet during monthly Steering Committee meetings (1st Wednesday of the month)
- Subcommittees will focus on prioritizing partner strategies
- Air District and CARB will provide updates on strategy implementation at each monthly Steering Committee meetings
- For Air District strategies and measures moving into implementation there will be an opportunity for Steering Committee and community participation

Deeper dive: Strategy subcommittees



Logistics

- Co-chaired by one Steering Committee community member and one agency member (leads discussion/report backs)
- Open to members of the public
- Staffed by Air District and/or WOEIP staff (coordination/content development/follow ups)
- Supported by implementation consultant (note taking/facilitation/etc)

Deeper dive: Strategy subcommittees



Role

- I. Prioritize Partner Strategies for Implementation (Jan April 2020)
 - Identify what additional information is needed
 - Recommend which strategies to pursue first
 - Consider type and level of effort needed
 - Apply Implementation Criteria (equity, neighborhoods, emissions, exposure, funding)
- II. Mid-year Pause and Reflect (May)
 - Is the subcommittee structure working? If not what should we change?
- III. Continue Implementation (June December....)
 - Celebrate successes
 - Identify and remove implementation barriers
 - Build new partnerships to accelerate implementation




