The Spare the Air Resource Teams began in 1991

9 Bay Area teams

Contra Costa County San Francisco County Sonoma County

Marin County San Mateo County Southern Alameda County

Napa County Santa Clara County Tri-Valley

Composed of business, civic, residents, and non-profit groups

Mission to improve local air quality

Create and implement projects that reduce air pollution

Contractor assists with facilitation of team meetings, coordinates team projects, and recruits team members


Spare the Air Resource Team Refocus

In July 2021, the District's Community Health, Equity and Justice Board Committee directed staff to focus projects on environmental justice communities. This includes:

- designated Assembly Bill 617 communities and communities awaiting designation
- projects based in communities with an overall score of 70 to 100 in

CalEnviroScreen 4.0.

Napa County is the only exception. See page 4 in the RFP.



Resource Team Activities

Resource Teams must demonstrate a positive impact in environmental justice communities and projects should focus on:

- 1. Partnering with the Air District to improve outreach and accessibility of incentive programs in environmental justice communities; and/or
- 2. Identifying culturally relevant ways to reduce mobile sources of pollution in environmental justice communities.

Seeking Organizations & Individuals Experienced in:

- •supporting community engagement and partnerships to influence behaviors at the community level;
- •engaging with environmental justice communities, low-income communities, communities with limited English proficiency, and communities of color;
- ·building and maintaining coalitions; and
- •fostering innovative ideas and collective action among coalition members

Objectives and Work Scope

Selected contractor(s) will establish and maintain a network of community-based Resource Teams to improve air quality of environmental justice communities throughout the Bay Area.

To meet objectives, contractor(s) will

- ☐ Convene Resource Team meetings
- ☐ Provide quarterly updates to the Air District
- Manage each Resource Team's budget and project scope
