Take this award letter to any dealership listed on the Clean Cars for All Authorized Dealership List on our website to purchase or lease your vehicle. The vehicle you purchase must have a higher combined fuel economy rating (MPG) than your vehicle to be scrapped.

Authorized dealers allow a minimum three-day decision-making window for used vehicles, where you can decide to keep or return the vehicle. Please note, some authorized dealerships may have restrictions that void the return period. Within 14 days after the return period for your replacement vehicle has expired, you must return to the dismantler for a Post-inspection to scrap your old vehicle. You must return to the same dismantler where you had your Pre-inspection performed.
