CMP, MSIF, & TFCA

• Carl Moyer Program (CMP)

- Created in 1998 to reduce emissions from heavy-duty engines
- Voluntary program that funds surplus emission reductions

• Mobile Source Incentive Fund (MSIF)

- AB 923 allowed for additional \$2 motor vehicle registration fee surcharge (12/04)
- CMP and LESBP projects eligible for MSIF funding

• Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA)

- Funding provided by a \$4 surcharge on motor vehicles
- Statutory authority for the TFCA and requirements of the program are set forth in California Health and Safety Code Sections 44241 and 44242




CMP Year 15


• On 2/4/13 District Board of Directors:

- Approved participation in CMP Year 15
- Authorized Executive Officer/APCO to execute contracts and amendments with grant awards up to \$100,000

CMP Project Recommendations over \$100k

- 2 Projects to reduce emissions from: 1 tractor, and 3 loaders
- ▶ \$468,650 in total awards
- Emission reductions: Over 2.6 TPY of criteria pollutants







TFCA FYE 2014

• On 6/5/13 District Board of Directors:

- Authorized funding for eligible Air District-led and Regional Fund project categories
- Authorized Executive Officer/APCO to execute contracts and amendments with grant awards up to \$100,000
- TFCA Project Recommendations over \$100k
 - ➢ None (As of May 6, 2014)
 - ⋟ \$5,225,937 in total awards to 36 projects (Attachment 4)
 - Emission reductions: Over 66 TPY of criteria pollutants



Lower Emissions School Bus Program (LESBP)

- On 5/1/13 the Board of Directors approved \$13.21 million MSIF allocation for LESBP projects
- Eligible projects: Replacement or retrofit of school buses, and the replacement of CNG school bus tanks
- Program demand exceeds available funds
- Staff proposes the allocation of an additional \$6.3 million in MSIF funding for eligible LESBP projects
 \$1.3 million for CNG tank replacement projects
 \$5 million for retrofits & replacement projects



Recommendations

Request the Committee recommend the Board of Directors:

- 1. Approve Carl Moyer Program projects with proposed grant awards over \$100,000;
- Allocate \$6.3 million in MSIF funds to Lower Emission School Bus Program projects; and,
- 3. Authorize the Executive Officer/APCO to enter into agreements with applicants for Lower Emission School Bus Program projects, and the recommended Carl Moyer Program projects.

Background Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA)

- Established in 1991, funding from \$4 surcharge on Bay Area motor vehicles for projects that reduce on-road vehicle emissions
- 60% of TFCA funds awarded directly by the Air District:
 - Air District led projects and programs (Spare the Air, Enhanced Mobile Source Enforcement & Commuter Benefits Project)
 - TFCA Regional Fund Program
- Remaining 40% is distributed to the 9-Bay Area Congestion Management Agencies (County Program Manager Fund)
- Board adopts policies and evaluation criteria annually
- TFCA is the sole funding source that can be used to fund **trip reduction and light-duty alternative fuel vehicle-based** projects



FYE 2015 TFCA Regional Fund

- On 5/21/14 District Board of Directors:
 - Authorized funding allocation for FYE 2015
 Shuttle & Ridesharing Services, Electronic Bike Lockers, and On Road Truck projects; and
 - Authorized Executive Officer/APCO to execute contracts and amendments with grant awards up to \$100,000
- Process and Timeline:
 - Issued draft FYE 2015 policies for public comment
 - Open call for projects by mid-2014 (tentative)







FYE 2015 TFCA Policies and Evaluation Criteria



Public Input Process

- Public Comment Period: March 26, 2014 to April 21, 2014
 - Policies posted on Air District Website
 - Notification sent to **TFCA grants e-mail list**
 - Stakeholder workshop meeting on April 2, 2014
 - 20 attendees (3 in person, 17 via webinar)
- 8 sets of comments received (Attachment C)
- Proposed policies reflect stakeholder input & Air District updates



Proposed Revisions

- New requirements for Shuttle/Feeder bus services
 - All applicants must provide a 5-year financing plan (Policies #27f & 28c)
 - Pilots must provide letter from transit agency that demonstrates applicant has attempted to coordinate services (Policy #28b)
- Clarification of prior requirements
 - Explicit **definition of duplication** (Policy #27d)
 - Language that specifies service must be open to the public (Policy #27c)
- Changes to C/E limits for Pilot services in PDAs and increase to C/E limits for both Existing and Pilot services
- Inclusion of Episodic Areas as part of evaluation
- Minor text additions and grammatical/formatting changes

1. Approve the proposed FYE 2015 TFCA Regional Fund Policies and Evaluation Criteria (FYE 2015 Policies) presented in Attachment A.

BRVP Vendor Selection



Background Bicycle Rack Voucher Program (BRVP)

- Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) is funding source for BRVP
- On 5/21/14 District Board of Directors:
 - Authorized up to \$900,000 in funding for BRVP and electronic locker projects in FYE 2015; and
 - Authorized Executive Officer/APCO to execute contracts and amendments with grant awards up to \$100,000



- Streamlined incentive program designed to provide all Bay Area public agencies access to discounted or nor cost bicycle parking racks at bulk rate pricing
- Air District contracts with rack vendors and issues public agencies vouchers in the amount of up to \$60 for each bicycle parking space provided (e.g., two space bicycle rack would qualify for \$120)
- July 30, 2012 District Board of Directors approved award of contracts to three vendors to provide equipment under the 1st Cycle of the BRVP



Results from Cycle 1 BRVP FYE 2014

- Three vendors: Creative Pipe, Inc., Dero Bike Rack Co., and Sportswork Northwest Inc.
- Applications accepted: 9/30/13 to 6/30/14
- 1st Cycle Results:
 - 23 agencies applied for and received vouchers
 - \$93,899 total awarded (approx.
 1,565 bike parking spaces)
 - \$360 \$12,000 range of awards





BAY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT

RFP Process and Results FYE 2015

- 2/22/14 RFP issued requesting proposals for administration of voucher project at a fixed, discounted price
- 3/6/14 Pre-bidder's webinar conference
- 3/24/14 RFP closed (5 bids received)
- 3/27/14 Evaluation committee comprised of representatives from Air District, City of San Mateo, and City & County of San Francisco

FYE 2015 RFP Process and Results (Cont'd)

Proposal (30 pts.)	27	25	25	25	26
Price (60 pts.)	53	58	53	55	55
Green/Local (10 pts.)	8	6	3	5	6
Total	88	89	81	85	87



Recommendation

Request the Committee recommend the Board of Directors:

1. Authorize the Executive Officer/APCO to enter into and execute all necessary contracts with Dero Bike Rack Co., Peak Racks Inc., Saris Cycling Group, Sportswork Northwest Inc., and Urban Racks not to exceed a total of \$860,000.
