
My Air Online Program Structure

Website Project Process





New Content Organization




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

IT PROCUREMENT CYCLE

• Prior to 2010

- IT procurement as budget allowed
- Created mix and match environment
- No discounts for volume procurement
- Since 2010
 - \circ 2M capital lease for IT infrastructure
 - Predictable annual expenditure
 - Uniform environment



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
2010 EQUIPMENT

Status

- \circ Equipment Procured in 2010 is approaching end of life
- $_{\odot}~$ Some still useful components can be re-used
- Risk
 - Expense, disruption and inefficiency of moving end-of life equipment to 375 Beale
- Solution
 - Prepare new infrastructure for 375 Beale in advance of move



IT INFRASTRUCTURE LEASE





RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Executive Officer/APCO to prepay one annual payment of \$368,000 for the Air District's IT infrastructure capital lease.
