CMP & MSIF Background

- Carl Moyer Program (CMP)
  - Created in 1998 to reduce emissions from heavy-duty engines
  - Voluntary program that funds surplus emission reductions
- Mobile Source Incentive Fund (MSIF)
  - ➢ AB 923 allowed for additional \$2 motor vehicle registration fee surcharge (12/04)
  - CMP and Lower Emission School Bus Program (LESBP) projects eligible for MSIF funding



CMP Year 18

- On 3/16/16 District Board of Directors:
  - > Approved participation in CMP Year 18
  - Authorized Executive Officer/APCO to execute contracts and amendments with grant awards up to \$100,000
- CMP Project Recommendations over \$100k:
  - 3 Projects to reduce emissions from 4 tractors and 2 passenger locomotives
  - > \$5,624,910 in total awards
  - Emission reductions: Over 21.1 TPY of criteria pollutants



### 18MOY37 – ACE Locomotive replacement project

#### **Project details**

- Replace two 1998, Tier 0+ passenger locomotives with Tier 4 locomotives
- ~86 k gallons/ year per locomotive
- 16 TPY NOx, 1.1 TPY ROG, and 0.48 TPY PM
- Significantly cleaner engines and increased passenger capacity

#### \$15 million (M) project cost


- ACE: \$7.5M Cap & Trade funds from CA State Transportation Agency
- **BAAQMD:** \$5M consisting of:
  - ~\$2.5M CMP Yr 17 multi-district funds & ~\$2.5 M CMP/MSIF
- *SJVAPCD*: ~\$2.5M








### CMP and MSIF Funds Awarded as of 2/2/17


Background

Calendar Year 2016 - \$70 million allocated to reduce emissions from mobile sources:

- Air District's primary grant programs:
  - Carl Moyer Program (CMP)
  - ➤ Mobile Source Incentive Fund (MSIF)
  - > Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA)
  - California Goods Movement Bond Program (GMP)
- \$9 million in TFCA funds to County Program Managers
- 63% to CARE areas, based on direct distribution by Air District (\$38M from \$61M total.)




# Grant Programs & Funding Streams






# 2016 Allocations: \$70 M






# 2016 Allocations by County

### 2016 MSIF & GMP

Mobile Source Incentive Fund - \$9.06 M

- Vehicle Buy Back Program: \$5.5 M
- Lower Emission School Bus Program: \$0.56 M
- Caltrain: \$3 M (of \$20 M award)


Goods Movement Program - \$27.6 M

- Trucks: \$16.7 M
- Locomotives: \$10.8 M
- TRUs & CHE: \$84.8 K

# 2016 SID Highlights

- EVs and Charge Stations:
  - ~ \$6 million awarded to 62 projects for
    - Installation of ~600 Level 2 chargers, 46 DC fast chargers
    - Purchase/lease of 42 light-duty and 61 heavyduty trucks and buses
- Shared Autonomous Vehicle (SAV):
  - \$2.05 million awarded to fund two SAV Pilot Projects
  - Deploy more than 99 electric SAVs in transit-service in Contra Costa and Alameda
- Off-road equipment:
  - \$13 million (of the \$20 million allocated) to Caltrain electrification project in 2016 funding plan






- Emissions reduced by \$61 million:
  - Particulate Matter (PM) 39 tons per year
  - ➢ Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) − 324 tons per year
  - ➢ Reactive Organic Gases (ROG) − 146 tons per year
  - ➤ Carbon Dioxide (CO2)\* 71,000 tons per year
- More than \$38 million to projects in CARE areas
  \*Not all programs report CO<sub>2</sub> reductions




# Allocations 2012-2016: \$228 M

# 2017 Funding Priorities

- Continued focus on impacted communities and trade corridors
- Investments to reduce diesel emissions
  - Small fleet (1 to 3) on-road trucks
  - Locomotives
  - Marine vessels
  - Agricultural and off-road equipment
- Advanced technologies/ Zero-emissions
  - Plug-in electric & hydrogen vehicles and infrastructure


# New Initiatives for 2017

# Funding Sources

#### • Carl Moyer Program (CMP)

- Created in 1998 to reduce emissions from heavy-duty engines
- Voluntary program that funds surplus emission reductions

#### • Mobile Source Incentive Fund (MSIF)

- ➤AB 923 allowed \$2 motor vehicle registration fee surcharge (12/04)
- ➤ CMP projects eligible for MSIF funding



- CA Air Resources Board (ARB) Year 19 funding
  - \$58.9 million statewide
  - Up to \$10.6 million for the Bay Area
  - ➢ 6.25% allocation for administrative costs
  - > Up to \$1.8 million in required match
- ARB 2017 CMP guidelines
- Continued focus on projects benefitting CARE areas
- Proposed \$3 million MSIF allocation for matching funds and additional CMP projects



# 2017 Caltrain Funding Plan

- July 29, 2015 Air District Board:
  - allocated \$20 million in MSIF funds for the Caltrain electrification project;
  - authorized the Executive Officer/APCO to enter into the necessary agreements for the project; and
  - requested a funding plan (between 2016 and 2020) be prepared and brought to the Board annually for approval.
- January 7, 2016 Air District executed project agreement
- March 16, 2016 Air District Board approved \$13 million initial funding plan
- Proposed 2017 \$3 million in MSIF funds (Total to date \$16 million)
- Staff will return in future years with updates to the funding plan until the entire allocation has been authorized



Recommendations

#### Recommend Board of Directors:

1. Adopt a resolution authorizing the Executive Officer/APCO to execute all necessary agreements with the California Air Resources Board (ARB) relating to the Air District's receipt of Carl Moyer Program (CMP) funds for fiscal year 2016-2017 (Program Year 19);

2. Allocate \$3 million in Mobile Source Incentive Funding to provide the required match funding and additional monies for projects eligible for funding under the CMP guidelines; and

3. Approve the proposed 2017 funding plan for the Caltrain Electrification project.
