# State Budget Update (2020-2021)



#### January 10, 2020 - Proposed Budget Released by Governor

Program	FY 19/20 Budget	FY 20/21 Proposal
Assembly Bill (AB) 617 – Implementation	\$50M	\$25M
AB 617 – Incentives	\$245M	\$200M
AB 617 - Technical Assistance	\$10M	\$10M
Clean Vehicle Rebate	\$238M	\$125M
Clean Truck & Bus	\$182M	\$150M
Ag Diesel Engine Replacement	\$65M	\$50M
Clean Cars for All/School Bus	\$65M	\$75M
Woodstove Replacement	\$0	\$0
AB 836 (Wicks) Clean Air Centers	\$0	\$5.5M

#### **Climate Budget includes:**

- Greenhouse Gas Revenue Fund
- Proposed Bond Measure for the November Ballot (≈ \$5 Billion)
- Climate Catalyst Fund (\$1 Billion) to support low-interest loans for capital projects

# Sponsored Bills

## **Assembly Bill 2882**



### **Ensuring Health and Safety of Schools**

Introduced by Assembly Members Chu and C. Garcia February 21, 2020

This bill will ensure the public health and safety of all students and school employees in California by requiring that private schools and charter schools meet the same siting requirements as public schools.

## **Assembly Bill 3211**



### **Toxic Air Contaminants**

Introduced by Assembly Members Bauer-Kahan and Bonta February 21, 2020

This bill will allow air districts to adopt local rules related to toxic air contaminants at indirect sources of air pollution, such as warehouses and distribution centers. This bill also allows collection of data that will help air districts work with these sources and communities to reduce health impacts.
