- Created in 1998

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- Assembly Bill (AB) 923 (2004)
  - Additional \$2 motor vehicle registration fee surcharge
- AB 617 (2017) established
  FARMER established by CARB in 2018
   Program (CAPP)
- CAPP funds distributed through Community Health Protection Program



## Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA)




- Statutory authority set forth in California Health and Safety Code Sections 44241 and 44242
- Funding provided by a \$4 surcharge on motor vehicles




# TFCA Project Recommendations over \$100k

- Recommend award of \$200,790 to one project to:
  - ✓ Install 1.9 miles of Class IV bikeways in Hayward
- Emissions Reductions
  - ✓ Over 0.22 TPY of criteria pollutants






