2. Discussion and Finalization of Draft Report on the Council's February 13, 2014 Meeting

Council Comments:

The Council and staff deliberated upon proposed revisions to the draft report on the Advisory Council meeting on February 23, 2014.

Public Comments:

David McCoard, Sierra Club, addressed the Council in support of the preliminary draft recommendation #1.

Council Action:

The Council requested the matter be agendized for further discussion in the future.

PRESENTATION

3. Air District Staff Present Information on Programs and Activities Involving Climate Protection

Eric Stevenson, Director of Technical Services, introduced Brian Bateman, Health and Science Officer, who gave the staff presentation *Overview of Energy Issues*, including world energy consumption and related carbon dioxide (CO_2) emissions by fuel type; worldwide delivered energy consumption by sector and fuel; growth in energy use in China and other developing countries; current U.S. energy consumption and projections by sector and fuel type; U.S. consumption, production and importation of petroleum and other liquid fuels; U.S. crude oil

production; trends and projections in U.S. crude oil supplies and quality; crude oil issues; crude slate and refinery CO_2 emissions; U.S. natural gas production; U.S. per capita energy use and energy-related CO_2 emissions; California energy consumption, sources and per capita use in 2011; California crude oil production; key California measures for reducing CO_2 emissions from energy use; Bay Area energy-related greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in 2011; Bay Area energy production and power plants; new Bay Area power plants; and summary.

NOTED PRESENT: Member O'Connor was noted present at 10:27 a.m.

The Council and staff discussed, at slide 26, *Bay Area Power Plants*, why geothermal was not included in the table.

Mr. Bateman concluded the presentation.

Council Comments:

The Council and staff discussed whether back-up generators and rooftop photovoltaic were included in the percentages provided on slide 26, *Bay Area Power Plants*; refinery emissions and crude slates in terms of changes in sulfur content, District permitting considerations and possible public health and safety concerns; an explanation of the component parts of "Oil Refining 19%" on slide 24, *Bay Area Energy-Related GHG Emissions 2012 – CO*₂e; the makeup of synthetic crude oil; the composition of tar sands crude if and when it arrives in California for refining; clarification of the effect of changes in crude oil slate and sulfur content on slide 15, *Crude Slate and Refinery CO*₂ *Emissions*; the opportunity for local change with global impact in the realm of energy use as opposed to reduced emissions; whether future staff presentations will provide more information on Air District programs and activities involving climate protection; whether studies are available about the environmental and societal implications of emerging U.S. crude oil production methods; the backup generator report from staff, including numbers and uses, and the viability of alternative fuel sources; backup generator requirements dictated by law; whether and how CO₂ and GHG are considered, tracked and reported out by the Air District; and whether Pacific Gas & Electric is utilizing flow batteries in its backup energy storage program.
