At the beginning of the hearings on the calendared Dockets, an opportunity is also provided for the public to speak on items of interest to the public that are within the Hearing Board's subject matter jurisdiction currently not calendared. Speakers will be limited to three (3) minutes each.

<u>DOCKET NOS. 3756 & 3757</u>: Variance Applications from Ameresco Keller Canyon RNG LLC (PITTSBURG, CA)

- 1) REGULAR VARIANCE FROM REGULATION 8, RULE 34, SECTION 412; REGULATION 2, RULE 1, SECTION 307, AND PERMIT CONDITIONS 27707.12 AND 27708.12 (DOCKET NO. 3756). Regarding request for extension of source testing deadline. Facility's Authority to Construct permit requires that an initial source test be conducted on the Thermal Oxidizer and Flare within 1,920 operating hours, not to exceed 120 days from the start of operation. On September 24, 2024, the Hearing Board granted Applicant a short variance (Docket No. 3753), which extended initial source testing deadline until November 20, 2024.
- 2) REGULAR VARIANCE FROM REGULATION 2, RULE 1, SECTION 307, AND PERMIT CONDITIONS 27705.3, 27707.9.c, 27708.9.c, 27707 (9)(a), 27708 (9)(a), 27707 (9)(d)(iii), AND 27708 (9)(d)(iii) (DOCKET NO. 3757). Regarding erroneous partially processed RNG total reduced sulfur concentration and Thermal Oxidizer and Enclosed Flare post-combustion SO₂ mass emissions limits in its Authority to Construct permit.
