Open Burning Seasons End for Range, Forest, and Marsh Management (Smoke Management Plans), Crop Replacement, and Orchard Pruning & Attrition

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District will end the permissible burn season for Range, Forest, and Marsh Management (Smoke Management Plans), Crop Replacement, and Orchard Pruning & Attrition within the Bay Area effective Monday, April 30, 2007.

Range, Forest, and Marsh Management (Smoke Management Plans),
Crop Replacement, and Orchard Pruning & Attrition can only take place on a
burn day as determined by the Air District. Air District meteorologists forecast
Burn/No Burn days by 3 PM for the following day. The information is recorded on
the Air District's toll-free number – 1 800 HELP-AIR (1 800 435-7247). The Air
