Open burning seasons close for Range and Forest Management, Crop Replacement, and Orchard Pruning & Attrition

SAN FRANCISCO - The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is announcing the close of the permissible burn seasons for Range and Forest Management, Crop Replacement, and Orchard Pruning & Attrition within the Bay Area effective Monday, April 30, 2008.

Range Management, Forest Management, Crop Replacement, and Orchard Pruning & Attrition can only take place on a burn day as determined by the Air District. Air District meteorologists forecast Burn/No Burn days by 3 PM for the following day. During open burn season, click on "Open Burn Status" under the "Advisories" header on the Air District website at www.baaqmd.gov to find out whether it is a permissive burn day.
