\$18 Million Available in Grant Funds

Air District Hosts Grant Workshops for Projects to Reduce Vehicle Emissions

San Francisco, CA - The Bay Area Air Quality Management District will be hosting a series of workshops to discuss grant application guidelines for projects to reduce motor vehicle emissions, the largest contributor to unhealthful levels of ozone (summertime "smog") and particulate matter. Because vehicle emissions are preventable pollutants, switching to cleaner vehicle technology and reducing usage can make a substantial difference to air quality in the region.

"Air-quality grant projects directed at transportation have many benefits, especially for residents who live in more heavily impacted communities" said Jack P. Broadbent, Executive Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District. "The Air District is directing funds towards those areas that have the greatest needs and where significant progress can be made."

The **Transportation Fund for Clean Air Regional Fund**, which provides grants for a range of projects, including the purchase or lease of new clean air vehicles, such as school buses and transit buses; repowers and retrofits of existing heavy-duty diesel vehicles; shuttle and feeder bus service to train stations; ridesharing programs; arterial management improvements; smart growth projects; and transit information projects.

Funding to retrofit, repower, or replace port/drayage trucks that operate in the Bay Area is available from the **Goods Movement Program**. Truck owners serving ports and intermodal rail yards may be eligible for funding to retrofit, repower, or purchase of a new truck.
