Fifth annual YES Conference encouraging youth action for clean air returns this weekend

WHAT: The free day-long YES Conference will bring together nearly 1,000 middle and high school

students from the nine San Francisco Bay Area counties to discuss topics ranging from

climate change and public health to transportation and air pollution.
