Air District hosts virtual workshop on Hanson Aggregates, CEMEX and other Bayview Hunters Point facilities

SAN FRANCISCO – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is conducting a virtual public workshop to present and receive comments on draft permit evaluations for Cemex Construction Materials Pacific, LLC and Hanson Aggregates Mid-Pacific, Inc. and to discuss other Bayview Hunters Point facilities located along Amador Street in Eastern San Francisco.

At the workshop, Air District staff will provide presentations on the air quality impacts from the facilities and respond to questions on the relevant draft permits and community concerns.
