Air District hosts virtual public hearing on proposed amendments to Regulation 6, Rule 5: Particulate Emissions from Refinery Fluidized Catalytic Cracking Units

SAN FRANCISCO – On Wednesday, June 2, the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Air District will conduct a virtual public hearing at 9:30 AM to consider adoption of the proposed amendments to Regulation 6, Rule 5: Particulate Emissions from Refinery Fluidized Catalytic Cracking Units.

WHAT: Fluidized catalytic cracking units are the largest single source of particulate

matter emissions at petroleum refineries. Further reductions of particulate matter emissions are needed to ensure attainment and maintenance of state and national ambient air quality standards and to provide clean air and public

health benefits.
