Air District to host Clean Air Talk series with Board Chair Hurt Public invited to share air quality questions, concerns

SAN FRANCISCO - Today, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District announced its Clean Air Talk series, featuring Air District Board Chair Davina Hurt, to be held in communities throughout the Bay Area.

The conversations will focus on community concerns and questions regarding air quality issues. The Air District welcomes all thoughts, questions and comments related to local air quality and climate change impacts. Public comments and concerns from each of the Clean Air Talk events will be shared with the Air District's 24-member Board of Directors at their monthly meetings.

"Much of the Air District's work is focused on air quality in the entire nine-county Bay Area," said Air District Board Chair Davina Hurt. "I want to hear from local communities about what their thoughts or concerns are on air quality in their neighborhoods and how that impacts them to help our Board make optimal decisions on good air guality programs."
