Refining Questions on Workforce	Currently 631 contractors list heat pump services (out of 21,611 that hold HVAC, plumbing or solar electrical license in 9-Bay Area County). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is this a surprising number? • What triggers motivate contractors to undergo heat pump training? • If a “watt diet” and pre-planning is key to avoiding panel upgrades, what training exists in these areas for electricians?
