This Advisory is provided to inform you about activities of the Air District which may affect your operation. It is intended to assist you in your effort to achieve and maintain compliance with applicable air pollution regulations.

ATTENTION: GRAPHIC ARTS PRINTING AND COATING FACILITIES

SUBJECT: REGISTRATION AND PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS

Regulation 8, Rule 20: Graphic Arts Printing and Coating Operations was amended on November 19, 2008. This rule regulates traditional printing, such as letterpress, lithographic, flexographic, gravure, screen printing AND now regulates commercial digital printing operations as a type of graphic arts operation.

Registration and Permitting

Regulation 2, Rule 1, pertaining to permits has also been amended for graphic arts operations. Effective July 1, 2009, any owner or operator of a graphics arts operation must comply with the following requirements:

Monthly VOC emissions in pounds (lbs)	Required Action
Less than 75 lbs per month	No Registration or Permitting required; must maintain
	records according to Section 8-20-503
75 lbs per month or more but less than 400 lbs per month	Facility Registration required*
400 lbs per month and greater	Facility Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate required

^{*} The owner/operator may choose to obtain a Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate in lieu of registering.

- Registration will be handled online at www.baagmd.gov.
- > A tool to estimate the emissions from your facility will be available online also.
- Your facility <u>cannot</u> have a mixture of permitted and registered equipment.
