Gasoline Dispensing Facility Compliance Reminder

PERMEATION HOSES

On September 24, 2014, California Air Resources Board (CARB) certified low permeation hoses for Assist Phase II Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) systems. Per CARB Certification Procedure CP-201, the use of certified low permeation hoses will be required four years after the certification date.

By September 24, 2018, all gasoline dispensing facilities (GDFs) with an Assist Phase II EVR system (Executive Orders VR-201 or VR-202) are required to upgrade all hoses to certified low permeation hoses.

Hoses listed in CARB Executive Orders VR-201/202 Revisions A-P may no longer be used. The following low permeation hoses are certified and must be used at these facilities.

Assist Phase II Manufacturer	Acceptable Hose Model
Veyance Technologies Inc.	Futura HVR Low Perm Hose
Franklin Fueling Systems	Healy Model 75 Low Perm Hose
Vapor System Technologies Inc.	V34EV Low Perm Hose
