PUBLIC NOTICE

TO: All residential and business neighbors located within 1,000 feet of the proposed new or modified sources of air pollution listed below.

FROM: Bay Area Air Quality Management District

RE: Permit Application #666748 for the following source(s) of air pollution:
**Two (2) Emergency Standby Diesel Engines
GOP5
475 Eccles Ave, South San Francisco, CA 94080**

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (the “Air District”) is a local agency that regulates stationary sources of air pollution such as factories, industrial sites, and gasoline stations.

Whenever we receive a permit application for a new or modified sources of toxic air contaminants located within 1,000 feet of a school site or within a community that is overburdened by air pollution, we notify the public about the proposed project. To comply with Air District requirements, we distribute or mail a Public Notice to the parents or guardians of students enrolled at schools located within ¼ mile, and all residents and businesses located within 1,000 feet, of the proposed sources.

You are receiving this Public Notice because a permit application has been filed with the District for the above referenced sources of air pollution. A description of the proposed project follows:

GOP5 has applied for an Authority to Construct and Permit to Operate for two (2) Emergency Standby Diesel Engines/Generators to provide backup power for the facility in the event of a power distribution failure. The proposed engines will be equipped with a Diesel Particulate Filter and Selective Catalytic Reductions to reduce emissions of Diesel Particulate Matter (PM) and Nitrogen Oxides (NO_x).

PRELIMINARY EVALUATION

The Air District has evaluated the permit application for the proposed project and has made a preliminary determination that the project is expected to comply with all applicable Air District, state, and federal air quality-related regulations, including the health risks resulting from toxic air contaminant emissions. The preliminary recommendation is to issue a permit for this project. After considering all comments received, the District will make a final determination.
