

NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District invites interested persons to submit written public comments on the proposed reopening of the Major Facility Review Permit for the following facility:

Major facilities are required to obtain operating permits under Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments, the Federal Operating Permit Program, and BAAQMD Regulation 2, Rule 6 - Major Facility Review. The permits summarize all air pollutant emission requirements that apply to each source of emissions at each facility.

The Air Pollution Control Officer invites written comment on the proposed changes to the Title V permit for the facility listed above. Comments must be received by July 25, 2022. Any interested person may also request a public hearing for this permit.

Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review by US EPA. If US EPA does not object to a proposed permit or a member of the public feels that the District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may, within 60 days after the end of the 45-day US EPA review period, petition US EPA to reconsider their decision to not object to the permit. Petitions shall be submitted to US EPA Region 9, Operating Permits Section, at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105.

The proposed Major Facility Review permit reopening, permit application, and statement of basis are available for public inspection in the Engineering Division of the District Headquarters located at 375 Beale Street, Suite 600, San Francisco, CA, 94105.
