The District proposed a minor permit revision for this facility on December 29, 2005, 2005. The main purpose of this proposed permit revision was to increase the liquid loading into storage tanks S-32 through S-45 from 145,000 barrels per day to 250,000 barrels per day. This revision was reviewed under District application 11862. The following sections were revised or added:

- Condition # 6184, Part 3 was changed to increase the liquid loading from 145,000 barrels per day to 250,000 barrels per day.
- In Condition # 6184, Part 9, the statement "150 lb/day, nor shall the Cumulative Increase from this facility exceed" was deleted to be consistent with the change from Part 3 under District's new source review application # 11861.
- Tables IV-A, B, C, F, I, and Tables VII-A, B, C, F, and H were modified to reflect the amendments to Regulation 8-5 - Storage of Organic Liquids, that were adopted on 11/27/02
- The SIP requirements of Regulation 8-5 were removed from Tables IV-A, B, C, F, I and Tables VII-A, B, C, F, and H because the current rule was adopted into the SIP in June 5, 2003.
- The type of limit was changed from NO₂ to NO_x in Table VII-D for S-22, Gasoline Loading Racks.
- The type of limit was changed from PM to PM(PM₁₀) in Table VII-D for S-22, Gasoline Loading Racks.
- Monitoring requirement citation 8-18, Section 401 was added and monitoring frequency of valves and flanges was changed from 10 years to quarterly in Table VII-I – Components.
- The definition of "NO₂ - Nitrogen Dioxide" was added to the glossary.
- The definition of "vessel calling" was added to the glossary.

No comments on this proposed minor revision were received from EPA or the facility.

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The District has decided to issue the revised permit incorporating the proposed minor revision and administrative amendment.
