**NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is reopening the Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The facility above received its initial Title V permit on December 1, 2003. The current Revision 1 of the permit was issued December 16, 2004. The permit is being proposed as a significant revision to incorporate thirteen applications that were not included in the December 16, 2004 permit. All changes are clearly shown in "strikeout/underline format" and have been addressed in the permit evaluation/statement of basis. The District invites comments on these changes. Comments made on other aspects of the permit will be accepted but may not be addressed at this time. All comments must be received by November 24, 2006. Prior to this closing date, the public may also request a public hearing for this draft revision of the permit.

The draft changes will result in an emissions increase of 0.0003 tons carbon monoxide per year.

After the public comment period and after any changes made in response to comments, a proposed revised permit will be sent to US EPA for their 45-day review. The public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105 to object to the permit within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review.
