

## NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District invites interested persons to submit written public comments on the proposed Reopening and Significant Revision to a Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The main purpose of the reopening is to incorporate the MSW Landfill NESHAP requirements into the permit. The District is also proposing to make a number of updates and corrections to improve consistency with other similar permits. The purposes of the significant revision are: to add a new flare to the permit, to revise several limits for the Keller Canyon Landfill and flares; and to expand the landfill gas collection system for the landfill. This significant revision will result in the following emission increases:

The Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer invites written comment on the above proposed reopening and significant revision. Comments must be received by January 20, 2006. The public may also request a public hearing for this significant revision.

Reopenings and significant revisions of Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed reopening or significant revision and District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the issuance of the permit.
