This permit renewal includes significant revisions pursuant to applications 23139, 30769, and 32030, minor revisions pursuant to applications 25719, 26423, 27668, 27031, 27065, 27310, 27396, 27565, 27792, 27800, 27991, 28104, 28446, 28549, 29059, 29274, 29417, 30783, 30808, 32023, and 30769, administrative amendment pursuant to application 26199.

Major facilities are required to obtain operating permits under Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments, the Federal Operating Permit Program and the District's Regulation 2, Rule 6 - Major Facility Review. The permits summarize all air-related requirements that apply to each source of emissions at each facility. The total facility emissions are expected to decrease as a result of the Renewable Fuels Project because various high-polluting equipment, such as the FCCU (fluidized catalytic cracking unit), have been shut down and permits relinquished since the current Title V permit was issued.

The Air Pollution Control Officer invites written comment on the proposed renewal Title V permit for the facility listed above. Comments must be received by August 28, 2023. Any interested person may also request a public hearing for this permit.

Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and the Air District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region 9, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of the 45-day US EPA review period, to reconsider the decision to not object to the permit.
