## SUBJECT: NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 21092 AND 21092.3 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE AND CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15072

**Project Title:** Proposed Amendments to Regulation 8, Rule 50: Polyester Resin Operations.

**Project Location:** The rule and proposed amendments apply within the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("District"), which includes all of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa Clara counties, and the southern portions of Solano and Sonoma counties.

**Project Description:** The District has regulatory authority over stationary sources of air pollution in the San Francisco Bay Area. Regulation 8, Rule 50 regulates volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions from the composite products manufacturing industry by setting standards for application techniques, by limiting the amount of VOC in gel coats and cleaning products and by limiting the monomer content of polyester resins used for the manufacture and repair of watercraft, recreational vehicle bodies, kitchen and bathware products, architectural products, computer board parts, pipelines storage tanks and a variety of other composite products. The primary VOC emitted by polyester resin operations is styrene, a toxic air contaminant(TAC).

The proposed amendments to Regulation 8, Rule 50 will reduce VOC and TAC emissions in at least three ways: (1) by lowering the allowable monomer content limits for resins; (2) by establishing monomer content limits for gel coats that will reduce the allowable VOC emissions; and (3) by requiring the use of non-atomizing spray systems when resins are applied to open molds. In addition, the District proposes to reduce VOC emissions from cleaning products by lowering the allowable VOC content.
