The maximum amount for an individual grant is \$300,000 over three years, with a maximum of \$100,000 per year. Grants must be used to design and implement strategies that foster authentic, empowered community participation in planning activities that improve a community's environmental health. The Air District specifically seeks to partner with community-based organizations in the Bay Area to uplift local efforts that improve air quality and public health. Community-based groups and local 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations serving environmental justice communities within the Bay Area are encouraged to apply.
