

Questions and Answers from FYE2016 Electronic Bicycle Locker Program Webinar on October 1, 2015

1) What locations are eligible for installation? What are the access requirements?

Answer: Lockers may only be installed at locations that are owned by the project sponsor (on public property) that serve one or more major activity centers (e.g., transit station, commercial building, or school).

Electronic bicycle lockers must be installed in compliance with all local, state, and federal requirements (including accessibility requirements) and be publicly accessible and available for use by all members of the public, at least during regular business hours of the near-by activity center.

2) Are the projects required to be located within or near a Community Air Risk Evaluation (CARE) or Priority Development Area (PDA)?

Answer: No. We collect this information for reporting purposes only.

3) What is the requirement for the bicycle parking description in adopted county-wide bicycle plan, Congestion Management Plan, or Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Regional Bicycle Plan?

Answer: Applicants must provide documentation that the proposed bicycle facility improvement is identified in the adopted countywide bicycle plan, a Congestion Management Program, or the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Regional Bicycle Plan.

4) Can the Air District provide a sample resolution or letter?

Answer: Examples of both a commitment letter and a Board-approved resolution can be found on the electronic bicycle locker program webpage (<http://www.baaqmd.gov/grant-funding/public-agencies/bike-racks-and-lockers>).

5) Can the funding be used to retrofit existing mechanical lockers?

Answer: No.

6) Can the cost of freight or installation be included in the reimbursable cost of the lockers?

Answer: Yes.

7) Can the District provide a list of recommended vendors?

Answer: No, the Air District does not maintain a list of vendors. However, potential applicants may contact Natalie LaGuardia at NLaguardia@baaqmd.gov to obtain contact information for agencies that previously received funding for electronic bicycle lockers. It is the applicant's responsibility to research electronic bicycle locker options and select a vendor.
